Circa 1831 Sword in good condition and SFE Sword with a clavier, with double S-shaped quillons, with a pommel decorated with a crown, in the extension of the fuse Beautiful chiseled and openwork clavier with anchor and laurel and oak foliage Fuse in good condition, with its filigree composed of a twisted wire and a doubled straight wire.
