It is also a history of the differences and disagreements between the Pope and the King of France. Eustache Le Noble is a French lawyer and writer. Attorney General at the Parliament of Metz and convicted of forging documents, he was imprisoned in the Conciergerie, where he fell in love and fled with Gabrielle Perreau, the Beautiful Grocer imprisoned for adultery. On the run with the young woman, he published, for a living, satirical dialogues on the affairs of the
