Rare revolutionary plate in Nevers faience from the 18th century. This faience plate dates from the end of the 18th century, the period of the French Revolution. It represents an allegorical scene linked to the end of famine, with a character holding a plant crown, probably symbolizing the hope of a new era of abundance after the periods of scarcity that preceded the Revolution.

Revolutionary faience from Nevers is particularly prized by collectors of folk art and enthusiasts of the history of the French Revolution. These pieces bear witness to the social and political upheavals of the time through folk art, and are valued for their historical importance and their characteristic naive expressiveness.
