Oil painting on copper depicting the penitent Mary Magdalene, dressed in a white drape falling from her shoulders. At her side is a vase of ointment, her traditional attribute. Her posture and attitude are reminiscent of the Penitent Magdalene painted by Titian and now kept at the Hermitage Museum in Saint Petersburg. Some chips in the paint layer.
