Diameter: 2.7 cm Weight: 7.7 g. On July 13, 1793, in Paris at 30 rue des Cordeliers, Charlotte Corday (assassinated the revolutionary Jean-Paul Marat at home in his bathtub. "The Friend of the People" whom she considered the main person responsible for the radicalization of the Revolution, plunging it into civil war.
