CAVALRY CAST IRON IN BLACK LEATHER FOR PISTOL AND RIFLE 1st EMPIRE THE NECK OF THE CAST IRON IS REINFORCED BY A WROUGHT IRON CIRCLE ATTACHED WITH COPPER WIRES; A SOFT LEATHER BRACE WITH ITS BUCKLE WAS PLACED ON THE HORSE'S NECK, A SMALL BAG, IN WIRE; CLOSED BY A BUTTON WAS FIXED BY TWO NAILS INSIDE THE CAST IRON, ANOTHER FABRIC WAS PLACED AT THE BOTTOM OF THE CAST IRON TO PROTECT THE TIP OF THE CANINE OF THE PISTOL; TWO ATTACHED LEATHER LOOPS WERE TO BE USED TO PLACE A RIFLE?
