SABER called Wakizashi signed Bunju Japan Edo period (1603-1868) Steel, wood, lacquer, silk, copper, gold, shibuichi, shakudo, brass Nagasa: 45.9; Nakago: 12.2 cm Sori: 0.4 cm? Hira Tsukuri blade, Mune Hikushi, Toran temper line. Kaeri Tsuyoshi type Boshi. Nakago Funa Gata and Ha Hagari Kuri Jiri, signed 'Bunju'. Copper Habaki covered with shibuichi, engraved on both sides with bamboo leaves in shakudo and silver. Ten-grooved wooden saya, covered with black lacquer with red highlights, decorated with a brass menuki representing Fukurokatsugi, who has a bag for carrying children. Kojiri, Kuri Gata and Koi Guchi in lacquered buffalo horn. Yellow silk sageo. Tsuka ito made of wood, covered with shagreen, braided with black silk. Menuki representing golden crabs on shakudo
