Period: 19th century, bronze in very good condition, on bronze base. All with very beautiful patina, Lost wax bronze. Signed: J. Verstappen, Belgian artist of the Belgian School. Subject: Hunting horn or hunting horn player.
Dimensions: height: 60 cm, width: 30 cm, depth: 25 cm. - 11 Kg. The horn is a hunting instrument. During hunting at Court, the hunting action is accompanied by trumpet blasts (fanfares) which allow the hunters to communicate with each other and with their dogs. The hunting horn was adopted by French hunting during the reign of Louis XV and the influence of his hunting master the Marquis de Dampierre². Since then, the hunting horn has been inseparable from hunting. It owes its significance and development to it. The practice of the horn is maintained by all
