Maurice Rogerol (1873-1946) Persian soldier, with his equipment, helmet, armor, shield, saber. Beautiful, extremely decorative Italian-style frame. Delf Moderne frame, custom-made, in the style of the painting. Biography: Maurice Rogerol, born in Douai (Nord) on March 26, 1873 and died in Taza (Morocco) on May 5, 1946, was a French painter and sculptor. Maurice Rogerol was born into a family of artists. His great-grandfather was a pewter potter and had a workshop located on rue Gambetta in Douai where he worked pewter with four workers. Brother of the painter, sculptor and ceramist Henri-Émile Rogerol (1877-1947), he received artistic training at the Douai School of Fine Arts.
