'Katatora' friction oracle from the 'Luba' Shankadi tribe of Congo - Africa - late 19th centuryThe katatora (or kashekesheke) among the Luba was a friction oracle. It was used by diviners (nganga) to consult the ancestors: by rubbing the object, the movement or stoppage indicated the answer.
