Lithography portrait of Isabella of Bourbon. Lithograph on Applied China, by Langlumé, drawn by Beaume after the painting by Peter Paul Rubens (1577-1640). Elisabeth of France or Isabella of Bourbon (1602-1644) was Queen of Spain from 1621 to her death and of Portugal from 1621 to 1640, as the first spouse of King Philip IV & III. She served as regent of Spain during the Catalan Revolt in 1640-42 and 1643-44. She was the eldest daughter of King Henry IV of France and his second spouse Marie de' Medici.
