From a young age, he showed a passion for drawing, which he practiced even before he could walk. Despite initial training in watchmaking, he quickly turned to the visual arts and joined the École des Beaux-Arts in Marseille. Between 1958 and 1968, he participated in numerous salons and group exhibitions in France. His career then took on an international
