Description

Large red chalk drawing by Charles-François DAUBIGNY depicting a herd of cows heading towards a river, a rabbit running away at the bottom right of the composition. Very beautiful work, richly animated, by one of the masters of the Barbizon school, monogrammed and bearing the stamp of the artist's post-mortem sale of 6-11 May 1878. This drawing would correspond to number 468 of this sale, a red chalk titled "cows going to drink" (in french "vaches allant boire", see last photos). Red chalk on paper glued to cardboard. Monogrammed bottom left "CD". Red stamp of the sale after death bottom right (intertwined letters CD), referenced by Lugt under the number L.51826 x 43 cms drawn part 28.5 x 44 cms entire sheet 44 x 60 cms with gilded frame 20th century.
