It clearly references the painting of the same subject by the Flemish artist Antoon van Dyck, both in theme and in style. The work is attributable to the Flemish school. This 17th-century oil on copper depicts the same subject as van Dyck's Crowning with Thorns. The strong stylistic references and thematic adherence suggest it was produced by a school that developed within the Flemish context, likely while van Dyck was still active. In particular, the chromatic range, the anatomical rendering of the figures, and the intense pathos conveyed in the image of Christ during the
