Ladislas Kijno, mixed media and crumpled kraft paper, 27 x 21.5 cm framed 37.5 x 44.5 cmPolish-born painter Ladislas Kijno is considered one of the major artists of the 20th century and a master of abstraction, specializing in the technique of crumpling and spraying on canvas.Ladislas Kijno was close to Louis Aragon, an encounter that influenced his work, often closely related to poetry. A guest of the Venice Biennale in 1980, the artist created several monumental works for religious buildings, including the rose window of the Notre-Dame de la Treille Cathedral in Lille. Kijno also created a representation of the Last Supper for the church on the Plateau d'Assy, in the commune of Passy (Haute-Savoie), decorated by the greatest artists
