The finely chased case is decorated with an elegant figure of Mercury, rendered with great refinement in every detail. The base features gilded bronze panels in relief with classically inspired allegorical scenes, emphasizing the neoclassical style typical of the period. The white enamel dial, signed Le Courvoisier, is framed by a gilded bezel and houses a high-quality mechanical movement, equipped with a quarter-hour, half-hour, and hour chime. An extraordinarily elegant piece, harmoniously combining art and technique, ideal for collectors and connoisseurs of fine antiques.
