Please note: small defects on the painting in the upper right corner, some wear of time on the frame, see photos. \* Léon Galand, whose full name was Léon Laurent Galand (1872-1960), was a French painter and illustrator. He was a student of Ernest Michel, Robert Delaunay, Gustave Moreau, Fernand Cormon and Joseph Blanc. He exhibited at the Salon des artistes français from 1904 and obtained a gold medal and a 2nd prize
