### Description

Roger Guerin (1896-1954) - Ceramic Ball Vase - 20th century Spherical stoneware vase with a nuanced gray-green glaze, with a smooth surface enhanced with subtle enamel effects. Its simple and balanced shape highlights the craftsmanship of the material. The piece is signed under the base and is part of a 20th-century ceramic production. Roger Guérin (1896-1954), a Belgian ceramist from Bouffioulx, distinguished himself in high-fired stoneware. Trained under Willem Delsaux, he established his own workshop after 1918 and moved from the Art Nouveau style to Art Deco, gaining international recognition from the 1920s onwards.
