## Description

This magnificent solid cherrywood chest of drawers, dating from the first half of the 20th century, embodies the timeless elegance and masterful craftsmanship specific to this period. Stamped on the back with a hot-iron salamander, the distinctive signature of André Mailfert (1884-1943). Mailfert was a French industrialist, painter, writer and cabinetmaker known for his high-quality reproductions of antique furniture. The chest of drawers is cleverly organized with two drawers in the belt, perfect for everyday objects, as well as two wider drawers in the body, providing considerable storage space. The refined details add a touch of sophistication: a false bronze entry and gilt bronze handles, delicately adorned with motifs of birds nestled on foliage. These decorative elements evoke a subtle balance
