KÉPI OF A LIEUTENANT-COLONEL OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE INFANTRY CORPS AND THE MEDICAL CORPS, model 1931. Cap and turban in fine madder cloth, black cloth band, silver and gold rank braids. On the front of the band, flaming grenade surmounting two branches of crossed laurel leaves in cannetille and gold sequins. Smooth gold half-spherical buttons holding the false chinstrap in the color of the weapon in so-called ribbed lines. Visor in strong black varnished cardboard, underside in blackened canvas, blackened and varnished leather rush sewn on horseback. Top of the cap provided with a triple Hungarian knot. Interior of headdress in black rayon, sweatband in thick blackened leather. Good condition. France. Third Republic.- This item is available for immediate
