Baroque Frame in Chiseled Bronze - 19th Century Splendid oval frame in finely chiseled bronze, dating back to the second half of the 19th century, crafted in the Baroque style with marked Rococo influences. The casting and attention to detail testify to the excellent craftsmanship of the era. The frame is embellished with rich decoration in the round: two mythological winged figures sit on the upper sides, while a grotesque mask with horns, typical of Baroque iconography, dominates the lower part. Dense floral motifs, scrolls, and cartouches complete the structure, making it a magnificent example of Baroque ornamentation.
