After studying art at the University of Los Angeles, he began working as a freelance designer. He quickly gained a reputation for his bold and avant-garde designs, using materials such as acrylic and plexiglass to create unique furniture. In the 1960s, Jones became famous for his clear acrylic furniture designs, which were featured in the most prestigious art galleries in New York and Los Angeles. He also worked with figures such as Frank Sinatra and Diana Ross,

creating custom furniture for their homes. Over the years, Jones expanded his work into lighting, creating lamps and fixtures in acrylic and brass.
