Etching depicting Corisca's escape, engraved by Richard Van Orley. Corisca manages to free herself from the satyr's hands. The satyr lies on the ground, Corisca's braid in his hand. This print from a series of twelve was used to illustrate Giovanni Battista Guarini's play II pastor fido (The Faithful Shepherd), sixth scene of the second act. A copy preserved at the Museum of Fine Arts in Ghent (Belgium). Period late 17th, early 18th century. Good general condition.
