Description

A rare pair of chairs, Veneto, first quarter of the 18th century. Made of walnut, the front is richly inlaid with cherry plum and olive burl, with a bouquet of flowers in the center of the backrest and a geometric motif running down the front legs. The seat has scalloped and molded edges, as does the backrest. Similar designs appear in the collections of the Museo Civico de Feltre (Belluno, Italy) and the Foresteria del Convento del Santo - Padua (Italy).
