Pair of five-light candelabras in 934 thousandths solid silver, Porto, early 20th century Superb pair of solid silver candelabras, Regency style, combining elegance and monumentality. Each candelabra has five lights and a removable upper part, allowing them to be used either as a complete candelabra version or as simple candlesticks. The light arms, also removable, are finely balanced and connected by an elegant central scroll. A matching and original silver snuffer completes the set. The candelabras demonstrate the Portuguese know-how of Porto at the beginning of the 20th century, with a very high-quality manufacture in first-grade solid silver (934 thousandths), heavy and robust. Their sober but majestic style recalls the English Regency creations, ideal for magnifying a

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reception table.
