Biography Flavio Poli (1900 -1984) was an Italian artist renowned for his glass creations.Born in 1900, he trained at the Istituto d'Arte di Venezia and began his career as a ceramist. In 1929, he joined IVAM(Industrie Vetraie Artistiche Murano) as a glassware designer. In 1934, he became artistic director of Barovier, Seguso & Ferro (later Seguso Vetri d'Arte), where he developed the celebrated sommerso style -- glass with multiple transparent layers, one over the other. After three years, he became a partner in the company, which he left in 1963. From 1964 to 1966, he headed the

artistic glass division of the Società Veneziana di Conterie e Cristallerie.
