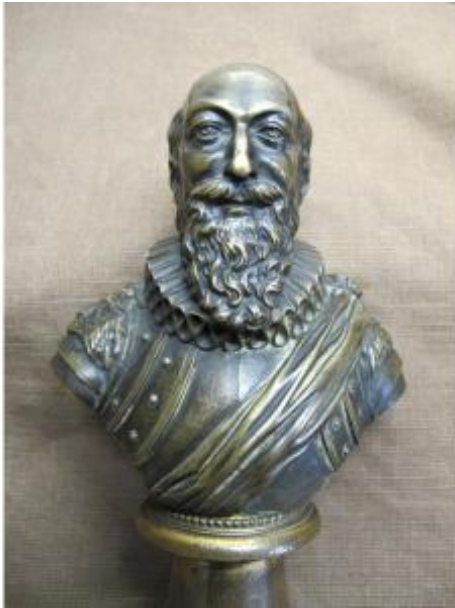




## Bronze Bust Of Sully, 19th Century
