This 16th century painting is a portrait of Marie Le Fèvre de Caumartin, wife of Claude le Tonnelier, Lord of Breteuil. She is depicted here from the front, sketching a slight smile. Adorned with jewels, her hair adorned with a tiara with a high collar forming a fine lace ruff, she is dressed in a rich dress as befits her noble status. The famous painter Jean-Marc Nattier (1685-1766) also painted her, representing her as Hebe, the Greek goddess of youth.
