The bell body shows simple lines and harmonious proportions, typical of production from the late 18th to early 19th century. The original iron clapper, secured with a double ring, is still present inside. A piece of great charm and historical value, perfect as a collector's item, decorative element, or example of Italian bronze casting art. Condition: excellent, with minor age-related wear. Even patina.
