The presence of matte palmettes on the base is a sign of superior quality, from a large Parisian manufacturer such as Dihl et Guérhard, Nast or Schoelcher. Beautiful gilding with matte and shiny gold (burnished with agate). Beautiful large piece, very decorative. Ideal for presenting fruit on a dining room table or adorning a fireplace or a chest of drawers in addition to candlesticks, or to form a complete garnish. Our cup is in very good condition to excellent condition, gilding overall very fresh with some very slight wear underneath. No damage to the porcelain or the openwork parts.
