Primavera (Printemps Art Workshop), Gustave Asch in Sainte-Radeguonde. Art Deco vase decorated with blue waves on a glazed background. Signed "Primavera" and hatchet mark for Gustave ASCH. This vase, designed by Gustave Asch for Primavera, embodies the elegance and boldness of French design from the 1920s and 1930s. Gustave Asch, a renowned artist and ceramist, left his mark on his era with creations combining purity of line and richness of patterns, often inspired by nature and primitive arts. Primavera, the art workshop of the Printemps department store, was able to enhance his talent by producing unique pieces, where ceramics become an object of art in their own right.
