Sheet size: 32.8 x 50 cm With frame: 76 x 59 cm Description This print belongs to the portfolio "The Ammonite's Dream", published in 1975, which includes a series of works in which Alechinsky deploys his characteristic graphic language, between gestural abstraction, writing and symbolic figuration. The Centre Pompidou holds a proof of this same lithograph (inv. AM 1976-170 (10)), donated by the artist in 1976. A rare feature: the copy presented here includes, in addition to the lithographed motif in green and black, inscriptions handwritten notes integrated by the
