Kilonda ceremonial or ceremonial axeSongye culture, Democratic Republic of CongoFirst half of the 20th centuryWood, iron, and copper H: 40; L: 33 cmThe triangular blade is made of openwork iron and decorated on both sides with twenty-two incised anthropomorphic faces and knots with twisted strands. It is held in place in a straight wooden handle wrapped with nailed copper inserts.
