




Charles Liozu (1866-1948), View Of Albi With A Steam Train

Charles LIOZU (1866-1948) Painter, writer, illustrator, poet in French and Occitan, Charles Liozu was born in Les Cabannes on October 6, 1866 and died in Cordes on November 8, 1948. A student of the Beaux-Arts in Toulouse and Paris, he was a drawing teacher at the high school and at the Municipal School of Drawing in Albi. He represented with humor the rural scenes, the physiognomies, the types and the customs of the Tarn region. He illustrated numerous magazines, catalogs, posters, scores, cultural documents and postcards reissued twenty years later. Oil on canvas 32x46 cm in very good condition.
