Large Spanish folding knife, 19th centuryImportant Spanish folding knife, dating from the 19th century, characterized by its long, tapered blade, preserved in its original shape. It has an engraved central groove and locks securely thanks to a system of locking notches, typical of quality manufacturing. The handle is covered with a finely embossed brass sheet and decorated with motifs, with at its end the small "barrel" characteristic of the traditional productions of Santa Cruz de Mudela and Andalusia. This ornament, a distinctive symbol, attests to the origin and authenticity of this type of knife, both utilitarian and prestigious. By its dimensions, its quality of manufacture and its state of preservation, this navaja stands out as a rare and sought-after piece. It perfectly illustrates the
