This lithograph entitled "Crossing the Rhine 1918 Return to the Native Country" is characteristic of Hansi's work. The scene is both narrative and symbolic. The work is made in the tradition of cutouts of Alsatian silhouettes from the early 20th century. This authentic and old work has its original baguette frame and glass. It bears Hansi's signature 1937 and a dedication. Jean-Jacques Waltz, alias Hansi or Uncle Hansi (1873-1951) is an Alsatian and French illustrator. Mainly known for his drawings of idyllic village scenes, his biting anti-German caricatures, but who was also a talented watercolorist. We point out that the work is pitted, note foxing in many places visible in the photos. The work remains in a presentable condition. Our photos allow you to appreciate the quality of the work.
