Description

This portrait is attributed to Katarzyna Opalinska (1680-1747), wife of Stanislaw Leszczynski (1677-1766), King of Poland and Duke of Lorraine. Queen of Poland from 1704 to 1709, then Duchess of Lorraine from 1737, she was the mother of Marie Leszczynska, future Queen of France and wife of Louis XV. The painting is presented in a carved and gilded wooden frame (18th century), decorated with floral relief. Although later than the canvas, this frame underlines the decorative importance and heritage value of the work

Biography of Katarzyna Opalinska
1680: Born into the Polish nobility.
1698: Married Stanislaw Leszczynski.
1704-1709: Queen of Poland. After the fall of her husband, she experienced exile across Europe (Sweden, Germany, Alsace).
1725: Her daughter
