Description

Solid bronze candlestick featuring a stem topped with a cylindrical socket and resting on a circular base. The simple execution of this candlestick is a fine testament to the art of Renaissance brasswork. Dimensions: H. 23.5 cm x D. 14.5 cm. France. Beautiful patina. Solid bronze. 16th Century. The word "dinanderie" comes from the name of the city of Dinant in Belgium, which, along with Liège, Namur, Huy, and the entire Meuse Valley, was a flourishing center for copper and brass work in the Middle Ages. "Dinanderie" then referred to the casting of brass, whereas today it refers to the art of beating metal, primarily copper but also tin, nickel silver, and brass, and shaping it with a hammer.
