The artist never wanted to sell this painting, it remained in the artist's studio until his death, he had dedicated it to his wife Robert VERNET-BONFORT born in 1934 in Marseille, he studied Art at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Marseille from 1948 to 1957, he won numerous prizes there.
