## Description

Oil on canvas depicting a battle scene with horses and

riders, painted by Eugène Courboin (La Fère 1851 - Paris 1925), a French

illustrator and painter active between the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

The artist, who studied at the École des Beaux-Arts from around 1878, devoted his work to the academic and historical genres, with particular attention to detail and a refined style. His paintings range from historical and mythological scenes to genre subjects, reflecting the artistic trends of his time.

The large-scale canvas measures  $132 \times 196 \text{ cm}$ , with
