Finely chiseled solid silver cane handle, decorated in high relief with sinuous dragons among the clouds and a large Chinese ideogram "?" (shòu), symbol of happiness and longevity. The domed upper part is decorated with stylized flowers and encircled by a dragon in the round, forming a pommel as decorative as it is pleasant in the hand. The finesse of the work, the vigor of the reliefs and the richness of the symbolism give this piece a prestigious character. More than a simple accessory, it is a true work of art, once intended to affirm the rank and elegance of its owner. Dimensions: 14 cm Some small traces of use and slight marks of depression, visible on the photos, which testify to its authenticity and antiquity.
