Round openwork top decorated on the edges with a series of vertical lines; it is openwork in its center and the top is striated for attaching boots. Top Ø 10 cm, width with branches 14 cm, H 14.2 cm. France. First Empire. Very good condition, gilding partly rubbed on the protruding parts.
