a rich Queen-shaped decoration on the belt and a bouquet of flowers on the two lower drawers and their sides.

Each

decoration is framed by a double discontinuous border of light wood and ebony, separated by fine checkerboard patterns.

The

uprights feature rosewood decoration framed by the same border. The crosspieces are raised at an angle and finished with tapered legs with simulated fluting, ending in gilt bronze caps.

The table is topped with a white marble top surrounded by an openwork gilt brass gallery.

Late 18th-century Parisian work, attributed to Etienne Avril (master in 1774)
