Description

Superb entomological specimens of Goliathus regius, also known as the royal Goliath beetle. Considered one of the largest and most prestigious beetles in the world, it is native to the forests of West Africa (Ivory Coast, Ghana, Nigeria). The first specimen, in excellent condition, has all its legs and antennae intact, with the contrasting and elegant markings characteristic of the species. The second, which is large, is more damaged: its mandibles are missing and its legs are badly deteriorated, with the exception of the two front ones. Goliathus regius are among the most sought-after African insects in entomological collections, both for their impressive size and for the rarity and beauty of their markings, which make each specimen unique. They are a real centrepiece for a cabinet
