Description

This original lithograph by Pablo Picasso, titled Pinturas de Picasso, was created in 1961 to advertise an exhibition dedicated to the artist. With its dimensions of 71 x 50 cm, it belongs to the great tradition of original posters designed by Picasso himself or closely supervised as part of his exhibitions. The poster, beyond its communication function, is a true work of art in itself: it testifies to the importance that Picasso attached to the printed image and its dissemination to the greatest number of people. Lithographic work occupies a central place in Picasso's career: from the end of the 1940s, he collaborated regularly with the Mourlot studio in Paris, where he found an exceptional field of experimentation. Lithography offered him a rare flexibility, allowing him to capture the

spontaneity of the line and the richness of the textures. Between 1945 and 1965, Picasso created more than 400 lithographs, varying in subject, style, and technique, from the simplicity of linear lines to compositions with complex flat tints. These prints, often linked to his exhibitions, illustrate his desire to make his art accessible to the public while remaining demanding in the quality of execution. Pinturas de Picasso is part of this approach: a strong, direct image, printed by a leading workshop, which combines the visual effectiveness of the poster with the artistic value of the print. Today, these original lithographs are highly sought after by collectors, as they embody Picasso's creative vitality and his unique relationship with printed art.
