Pretty tool-embossed copper scoop, in the shape of a small pot with two ears, (its brass handle is a reuse, the original was wrought iron). Small size: 12cm x 12cm, but rich decoration, punctuated by majestic acanthus leaves. Below a rosette, on one side: coat of arms of a great Italian family, on the other, three-quarter portrait of the Doge of Venice, recognizable by his "zoia", the Ducal horn which crowned the highest magistrate of Republic of Venice. This Doge looks a lot like Francesco Erizzo, 98th Doge of Venice (1631-1646), see last photo...Condition is not perfect, small hole, numerous small repairs only detectable on tinned interior.
