LELONG Pierre Born March 23, 1908 in Paris. Died in 1984 in Paris. 20th century. French. Painter of animated scenes, still lifes, lithographer, illustrator. Postcubist. He spent a long time in the Antilles, and came to painting late. In Paris, he participated in various Salons: the Independents, Autumn, May, Comparisons, Painters Witnesses of Their Time, for which he received the Grand Prix in 1972. He also showed collections of his paintings in solo exhibitions, including: 1967 New York; 1969 Paris Carlier gallery; 1971 Chicago; 1972 Tokyo, Paris; 1973 Cannes; etc. Apart from his paintings, he created several wall decorations, and lithographs for many literary works, including Shakespeare,
