Description

Solid silver vase has a sober, slightly curved silhouette, resting on a polished circular pedestal that interacts with the upper edge, also polished and shiny. The surface of the body contrasts with its particular treatment: a matte granulation, punctuated by small irregular hollow prints, which animate the material with effects of light and shadow. This decoration, both discreet and refined, gives the object an organic and contemporary character, reminiscent of natural or mineral textures.
