It has a belt drawer, surmounting two drawers in the body, offering both storage and visual balance. The top in Belgian granite marble, soberly speckled, adds a mineral touch which contrasts subtly with the warmth of the wood. Two detached columns, adorned with chiseled bronze capitals, harmoniously frame the whole. They rise up to a concave base forming a spacer, giving this piece of furniture an elegant stability and a stylistic signature typical of the Empire aesthetic.
