cmToulouse-Lautrec's "bottle cane" or "drinking cane" is a hollow cane, often with a flask or secret compartment, that the painter used to conceal and transport alcohol, especially absinthe and cognac, so that he always had some at hand.A bottle cane:

This type of cane is an example of a cane with a device, meaning that it conceals a function or other use.Material: These canes can be made of pewter or wood, and their sections unscrew to reveal a glass vial with a stopper and small glasses.Collectible: Bottle canes inspired by those of Toulouse-Lautrec are now collectibles, often given on special occasions.
